The Planning Commission is putting out applications for 2 seats that are available. The applications are posted on the Stockton Facebook page and at Town Hall.


9. Walk St. Bid Discussion

Council had a discussion about bids to repave Walk St. The majority of council feels that the least expensive option would be best. There will be a budget amendment next month.


