August- There were 3 total details, 1 arrest and 2 significant incidents.

Significant incidents- August 7, 2019 Deputy stopped a suspicious vehicle in the area of the gas station and found the occupants had marijuana inside the vehicle. One adult male was arrested. August 27, 2019 Deputy's assisted Stockton units on a traffic stop where several people were arrested.

6. Department Reports

- a. Stockton Police Department-Chief Romney-See attached

August- There were 43 traffic stops, 31 calls, 04 call outs and 03 County assists.

Use of force- Psychiatric: 18 year old female who suffers from a mental illness was actively attacking her mother. Officers had to physically restrain her and force her to stop. A use of force report was filed with the case and it was determined the actions met policy and procedure.

September- There were 56 traffic stops, 27 calls, 10 call outs and 04 County assists.

Use of force- Suicide attempt: 30 year old female attempted to commit suicide by taking a lot of medication. She refused to go to the hospital and was forced to be pink sheeted (involuntary commitment). She attempted to flee when officers first arrived. She had to be restrained for a short period of time until she calmed down. A use of force report was filed with the case and it was determined the actions met policy and procedure. Psychiatric: 18 year old female who suffers from a mental illness was actively attacking her mother. Officers had to physically restrain her and force her to stop. She was transported to the hospital by ambulance. A use of force report was filed with the case and it was determined the actions met policy and procedure.

Major crimes- 1. 4 possessions of methamphetamine/heroin/narcotics, (Including one incident in which Stockton Police located a half of a pound of heroin, a quarter pound of meth, and hundreds of dollars) 2. 3 family fights/assaults. 3. 2 thefts- suspects were located and charged with the thefts.

Nuisances- We continue to receive complaints and are investigating/taking action on overgrown weeds. A few homes have come into compliance with the law.

Community oriented policing- The annual 'Guns and Hoses' trick or treat will be held at the Stockton Fire Department on October 31, 2019 at 6:00 pm.

- b. Stockton Fire Department-Chief Huffman/Assistant Chief Thatcher

August- There were 31 calls, 12% were in Town. Most of those calls were Wild Land calls.

September- There were 13 calls, 53% were in Town. The Fire Chief of Rush Valley has been the Fire Chief for a 30+ years and has stepped down as Fire Chief. Amy Lyman and Chief Huffman did a controlled fire burn west of South Rim. Libby Bowden has a month left in her EMT class. Elections coming up in November for officers, chief and assistant chief.


12. Ordinance 2019-14 Filing fee for elected official
