6. Department Reports

a. Stockton Police Department-Chief Romney

Last month we had 37 traffic stops, 40 calls, 04 call outs and 08 County assists.

Use of force- 1. One female resisted arrest and the Police had to use control hold to put her into cuffs and drag her to the Police vehicle. 2. One male resisted arrest and had the Police had to use control hold to put him into cuffs and drag to the Police vehicle. 3. One male fleeing in a high speed pursuit. He was brought out at gun point. 4. One male intoxicated and resisting arrest the Police had to use control hold to put him into cuffs and drag to the Police vehicle.

Major crimes- 1. Two drug cases (heroin and methamphetamine) 2. Six warrants (three were no bail warrants, fugitives from AP&P) 3. One high speed chase. 4. Three domestic violence's.

Nuisances- 1. Increase in barking dogs. Three citations were issued for this offense.

Community oriented policing- 1. Officer Connor Curtis represented the Stockton Police Department at the funeral for fallen K9 Officer Hondo. He was killed in the line of duty on February 13, 2020 while assisting US Marshals in apprehending a wanted a fugitive.

b. Stockton Fire Department-Chief Huffman/Assistant Chief Thatcher

Last month we had 12 calls, 25% were in Town.

The last two months the Fire Department has had meetings with the County on trying to create a hazmat response team. There were two CWPP meetings in Stockton a couple weeks ago for South Rim and Stockton.

Burn season is here. To get your free burn permit go to [www.air.utah.gov](http://www.air.utah.gov) the website has guidance on what days you can burn and what days you can't burn. Any residents in the Town of Stockton that wants to burn will need to bring their information to Chief Huffman. If anyone needs assistance the Fire Department can assist.
