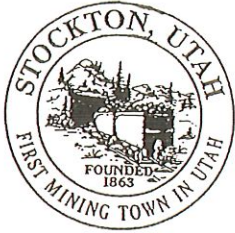

Last month we had 15 calls, 13 medicals and 2 fires. 60% were in Town.
Kathleen Memmott has retired and will no longer be a volunteer for the Fire Department.

Donald West passed away from COVID-19. He was the Fire Chief for over 43 years. The Fire Department will be doing a drive by for him on Saturday during the funeral and will also be doing a drive by at his residence to say their final goodbyes. Donald West will be missed.

The SCBA bottles for the Fire Department have all expired. The life span for those is 15 years. The Fire Department needs to get new bottles and are looking at getting different prices for those and will bring back an estimate to the Council next month.
