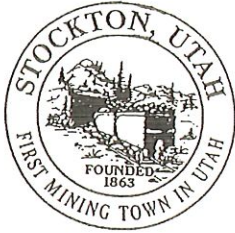

#### 6. Tom Daniels - UDEQ - Briefing on Drone Flyover of Bauer

At the end of April (anticipated April 26<sup>th</sup>- 30<sup>th</sup> 2021) the UDEQ DERR staff will take soil samples at the Bauer Mill Tailings Site. All samples will be analyzed on site with a portable analysis unit. A selection of samples will be sent to a contracted laboratory for confirmation analysis.

Between July 10 2021- August 10 2021 the staff will be doing an unmanned aerial flyover. It will capture hyperspectral imagery of the area to assess surface soil, both in areas that have not been involved with mining activity and areas that have visibility staining from the Bauer Tailings. These samples will be analyzed for metals concentrations using the handheld x-ray fluorometer. The flight path does not cross over any homes, should any incidental images be taken, they will be removed or blurred in final products to maintain privacy.

#### 8. Department Reports

a. Stockton Police Department-Chief Romney

Within the last two months, we've had a total of 106 calls. 2 alarm, 5 agency assists, 5 animal control, 1 background check, 2 burglary, 1 child abuse, 1 custodial interference, 8 drugs, 3 fire assists, 7 follow ups, 2 fraud, 2 harassment, 3 intoxicated person, 1 juvenile problem, 1 medical assist, 8 nuisance, 1 sex offense, 2 shots fired, 3 suicide/psychiatric, 10 suspicious, 1 theft, 5 traffic accidents, 8 traffic offenses, 2 trespassing, 1 vagrant, 8 VIN inspections, 2 wanted person/fugitive, 2 hang ups 911. 59 dedicated patrol, 24 arrests, 46 traffic stops and 6 County assists (back up).

b. Stockton Fire Department-Chief Huffman/Assistant Chief Thatcher  
Last month we had 10 calls, 1 in Town, 3 fires, 6 rescues and 1 EMS. The Fire Department found some quotes on SCBA Bottles. For 20 bottles it will be around \$22,000 for new bottles. ATK (Northrop Grumman) gifted the Fire Department their SCBA bottles. That will give the Fire Department a few years' worth of SCBA bottles.  
The Fire Department is still working with the County on a Resolution to get better funding. Libby Bowden is one test away before she finishes EMT (Advanced). Amy Lyman has 2 classes left to get her inspector one certification.  
The Fire Department is hoping to do the annual spring clean-up in May.

We are getting very little use on the Ball Park. Our rental fee is a little more expensive than most ball parks. The Council may want to revisit the rental fee and lower it, so the ball park gets used more.
