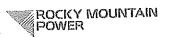

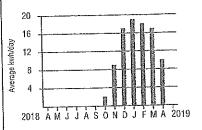

a. Stockton Police Department-Chief Romney-See attached Last month we had 32 traffic stops, 37 calls, 12 call outs, 04 county cases.

Use of force: On April 28, 2019 Stockton Police responded to a domestic in progress. After investigating, one male was arrested. He resisted arrest and a brief struggle with officers resulted. Control holds were applied to affect the arrest. A use of force report and investigation was completed and it was ruled that officers only used enough force as reasonably necessary to safely affect the arrest.

Major crimes: 1. Two domestic violence calls, 2. One possession of methamphetamine. 3. Five warrants. 4. One burglary. 5. One custodial interference.

Nuisances: Code 10-10-21: Recreation vehicles and mobile homes prohibited; exceptions-Recreation vehicles: It shall be unlawful to place any recreation vehicle on any lot or parcel of land and to use the same for human habitation, except when located in a recreation vehicle court.

Community oriented policing: Chief Romney had the privilege of being requested to teach, interview and interrogation as well as victimology at the Police Academy that has recently started in Tooele County. There were half a dozen cadets in the first session.
