Town of Stockton Residents:

In light of the recent incidents of last week (June 8-13) I would like to address a few subjects.

The fire at the corner of Dutch Avenue and Johnson Street was caused by a suspected arsonist. Thankfully the fire was extinguished before it could have caused serious damage. Thank you to our [Stockton Utah Fire Department](#) for the quick response.

I have through the proper authorities begun contacting the landowner of where the fire started to have the property cleared. What that exactly means is yet to be determined but we are working on a resolution. There are properties in town that are being addressed as to being fire hazards and the owners will be notified shortly. We have been identifying those properties since the beginning of the year. We have mentioned in the town's monthly newsletter that fire mitigation needs to happen. Then there was the South Mountain Fire which caused us concern for a period of time, once again we were spared by weather and our fire departments great work.

So let me get to the point the weather may not work in our favor and firefighters may not be able to get to us in time of need. So let's all be good neighbors and "mitigate" the fire risk in and around the Town of Stockton. Please mow your yards, cut your weeds, remove brush from your property minimize any chance for fire to start around your home. It has been observed that some residents have placed their yard waste in the alleyways and are not disposing of them properly. Find someone to help you to take your yard waste to the dump.

We are not on water restrictions as of right now, so water your yards and tomato plants and flowers. But, be responsible and conserve water at the same time. Folks it's only going to get hotter from here.

One last item, with the exception of a previous approved property owner there are several people living in campers and RV's in the town. This is prohibited by town ordinance. The persons and the locations that have been identified need to remedy there situation before the end of June.

Check on your neighbors, be vigilant to your surroundings. If you see it report it!
